From the Principal's Desk

Kia ora

Today is the last day for Mrs Alice Cade as our acting Deputy Principal and on Monday Mrs Kath Luoni will return to the role following the completion of her Teach NZ Study Award for the past 32 weeks. Alice has been outstanding in this role and the experience has certainly ignited an interest for Alice to become a permanently appointed senior leader in the future. The staff and students have greatly appreciated her caring nature and energetic work habits and collectively wish to thank her for the challenges she has accepted and the manner in which she has directed the school during this time.

Tonight the pool committee have organised their major fundraising event of the year, 'The Fireworks Extravaganza', at the Wyndham racecourse. Our pool has been totally upgraded and is now a high quality community facility which needs funds raised at events like this in order to maintain its quality and improve those features that make it even better. Please support this event tonight.

NCEA exams seem to be going well for our senior students and it has been pleasing to see them turn up well organised and serious about the importance of passing external standards. Looking through the current standings of our Year 11 to 13 students, there is plenty at stake for a number of them. Although most of our Year 12 students already have passed level 2 a good number will receive endorsements if they plan carefully and apply themselves in the exams. These grades become important when students line up against others of their age to seek employment or places in tertiary institutions. I was informed today that only one Year 11 student has not passed their numeracy requirements and a small number are still working towards passing their literacy. Staff have worked hard with students to get them this far and I fully appreciate the extra time and energy they put in for the students.

While exams are moving along, so is the time for our Year 7 to 10 students. It is crucial that each day is still considered an important one for learning and that students don't get a mind-set that the term is all but over. There are numerous assessment tasks still to be completed, staff are working on report writing and preparing for the Year 10 Mayora Camp and the Integrated Curriculum days.

On Friday 4 December we will welcome all our new 2016 students to the school on our New Entrants Day. Currently we have the paperwork for 52 students and are awaiting final enrolments from a few more that we are aware of. We certainly look forward to welcoming all these new students and their families.

Science Roadshow

On Thursday 5 November the Science Road Show came to Menzies College. This is run by the Ministry of Education and offers authentic learning experiences to students. The show featured two presentations and an opportunity for students to explore a range of science based activities using the show's interactive stations. During one of the interactive presentations, the students learnt about water and how long it spends in its various forms before it becomes drinking water again. The students also learnt some cool tricks where water can defy common belief and remain upside down inside a beaker held in place by a piece of thin metal guaze as surface tension allows the molecules of water to create a seal that will hold the water in place. In the second show the students looked at the uses of electricity and its power to jump gaps and create lightening. In between these times the students then moved round the 80 interactive exhibits.

Board of Trustees Report

At our Board meeting in October we were shown the results of a staff wellness survey. This was based around questions previously provided by NZCER and altered slightly to fit our school. Twenty-five staff gave us their feedback in an anonymous online survey. There is a large amount of data to be looked through and this will be discussed at our next meeting. We would like to thank the staff who participated.

We also looked at the results of a Health Consultation Mark Kerslake organised and presented to parents at the Options Night. A positive community response was noted. Thanks must go to Mark for presenting this well and also for the time he put in to organising and then collating the data for the Board.

We also looked into the draft budget for next year and have organised a date for reviewing and renewing the school Charter. The Charter is a document where amongst other things, we can specify what goals the school can work towards, whether these be one year, two, or three year plans. We also note how and when we can achieve these, along with what it will look like when they are achieved. It can be a time consuming process receiving feedback from staff and Heads of Department to set realistic and challenging goals which will benefit the students at Menzies College. After this document is drafted it is then sent to the Ministry for fine-tuning and acceptance. Thank you to the staff and Gerry for the behind-the-scenes work that goes in to this.

Other aspects:

- The school roll is constantly increasing with a strong influx of new students for 2016.
- School finances are healthy.
- NCEA credits are being achieved, with some hard work paying off for deserving students. Well done.
- The new school uniform seems to be a much talked about subject, with mufti Fridays for Year 13's being well received.
- The date for the school ball was altered after discussions about dates clashing with rugby and netball matches.
- Several school camps were approved. Thanks for the preparation of the paperwork and undertaking of memorable camps for our students.
- We welcomed Samuel Moncur as our new student representative on the Board of Trustees.
